


2022 Annual Report

2022 Year in Review

The Foundation took big strides in its first complete year since incorporation in June 2021. Key accomplishments include the launch of an online application for Silver, Gold, and Platinum Level Grants, formation of a Grant Committee to review applications and recommend recipients for Board final approval, and completion of four established grant cycles in March, June, September and December. The Foundation also hired its first employee to serve as Grants Analyst, initiated its first multi-year grant, and donated \$15,000 to local organizations at each of 4 Blue Foundry Bank branch openings. Blue Foundry Charitable Foundation supported 132 New Jersey non-profit organizations with grants and donations totaling \$585,855, fulfilling its required giving for 2022.
